

## Things to know:

- Parents/guardians are responsible for transportation to and from Camp Bimini.
- Camp Bimini reserves the right to dismiss any camper who in the camp's opinion demonstrates a hazard to the safety and/or well-being of the camp, himself/herself, or others, as well as any camper who does not adhere to the rules and regulations of the camp. No refund will be given. see our Discipline of a Camper Policy.
- Campers sent home due to homesickness/homelickness will not be given a refund.
- It is strongly recommended that all campers remain at camp for the full camp period. Please endeavour to schedule appointments and other occasions for a time when your child is not registered for camp. Leaving camp breaks up the program for the camper which in turn affects the camper's experience of Bimini. Exceptions are made for family or medical emergencies.
- Cancellation policy: A full refund on or before June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2013. A full refund less a \$25 fee on or after June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Registration fee is nonrefundable seven days prior to camp, unless a medical certificate is supplied.
- In order to ensure all children get a chance to attend one week of camp, children may only register for one week of camp per summer (this does not include Family Camp or the June Leadership Camp).
- Pack medications on the top of luggage or carry them to registration. All prescription and over-the-counter medications (in original containers please) will be administered by the camp nurse/first aider. We strongly recommend continuation of medication at camp.
- Registration takes time. Those first faces a camper meets are important. So if you do not like to wait in line, come a little later, like 3:45 pm. You might not get a top bunk though. We take a minute with each camper to ensure that the camper knows who we are and who to talk to about something great and not so great (we hope the not so great times are non-existent or few). It is important to us that all feel welcomed.
